2017 Year 12 Results

I am delighted to be able to announce the impressive results achieved by the Year 12 students who undertook the Queensland Certificate of Education, and in particular those students who achieved an OP. These results speak enormously well of this group of young people, reflective of their hard work, grit and talent, as well as of the sterling efforts of their teachers.

In summary:

- 100% of students achieved their QCE
- 3 students achieved an OP 1
- 17.8% of students achieved an OP 1 or 2, as compared with the QLD average of 6.95%
- 76.5% of students graduated with an additional qualification, from Certificate I to Diploma

Most significant of the statistics is that **64% of students achieved an OP between 1 and 5**, as compared with the QLD average of 22.13%.

These results are the best in the College's history, and ones of which we should be enormously proud.

Amongst the students there were many exceptional individual achievements. Some of these were incredible achievements at the top end, with Dux of the College Sarah Ketter, Proxime Accessit Jessica Lythall and Caltex All Rounder awardee Bonnie Cosgrove all achieving an OP 1. As important as these top achievements are the number of students who have overcome significant challenges to achieve grades and results that reflect new personal bests of which they should be proud.

As a school we take great pride in the achievements recorded by all of our students, and the ways in which they have established a platform of learning habits and grades that will act as the scaffold for their future success.

These results are also an indication of the College's ongoing commitment to providing an excellent learning experience, and I offer my thanks to Wendy Jurss, Dean of Curriculum, for her amazing work in leading teaching and learning at the College, the Year 12 subject teachers, and the hard work and expertise of all of the teachers of TSAC for their work in preparing students for these successes over many years.
