2024 Senior Years Snow Tour

Dear Secondary Students, Parents and Guardians

In 2024, we are planning a Senior Years Ski Trip to Queenstown, New Zealand. This tour is planned to occur from 13-20 September 2024. This is during the first week of the September holidays.

The fees for this non-compulsory tour will be approximately \$3800.

Costs will be finalised once the tour numbers are known. A payment schedule will be prepared and communicated when final costings are known. It is anticipated the second deposit will be due in late January 2024.

Tour Details:

- This non-compulsory tour will take place from Friday 13 September – Friday 20 September 2024.
- The tour is open to students who are in Years 11 and 12 in 2024
- The expected tour fee is approximately \$3800

The tour fees will include:

- Return flights with Virgin Australia,
- Private coach charter to tour activities,
- Multi-share accommodation at Reavers Lodge,
- Wanahaka Maori welcome,
- Coronet Peak and Remarkables 5-day lift and lesson pass,
- Skis/poles/boots or Snowboard/boots and helmet/wrist guard hire,
- KJet boat ride and underwater experience,
- Skyline Queenstown goldola/dinner/luge experience,
- TSS Earnslaw and Walter Park Farm experience and BBQ buffet lunch, and
- breakfast and dinner at accommodation daily.
- Souvenir Tour Jacket

Please note, the tour fees do not cover meals during travel, communication costs, lunches, clothing hire and Snowsports/Travel insurance.

Optional tour costs include:

- Ski/Snowboard clothing hire - \$115 (approximate cost)
- Travel Insurance (including Snowsports cover) - \$120 (approximate cost)

If you would like your child to attend the 2024 Senior Years Snow Tour, please confirm their place by contacting Secondary Campus Student Reception. Payment can be made over the phone or in person.

Acceptance and payment of the \$350 NON-refundable deposit is due by Thursday 30 November 2023.



By paying the Non-refundable deposit, you are committing to the tour and meeting all payments by the due dates. If we do not reach the minimum number, the tour will not proceed, and the \$350 Non-refundable payment will be returned.

It is the policy of the College that participation in College tours is conditional on all College fees being up to date. The Senior Years Snow tour is a non-compulsory tour. Non-compulsory tours cannot be billed to College fee accounts and paid via Edstart.

As per the College's Domestic and International Tours policy and procedure, should this tour become over-subscribed by 30 November 2023, preference is given in this order: Year 12 students and then Year 11 students. Applicants will be placed in a ballot to generate a list of confirmed participants and a wait list. Should positions become available on the tour, students on the waitlist and their parents will be contacted in the order that they appear on the wait list.
