The GBC Sports Competition for the remainder of 2020

The Greater Brisbane Conference (GBC) continues to strive to provide students of member schools with a quality sporting program. A significant component of this is to provide a full round of competition for students, however COVID-19 issues have continued to cause restrictions and create challenges.

The GBC Management Committee has made the following decisions in the best interests of the health and safety of students, staff and community members;

- The GBC & GBC Primary Athletics Carnivals have been cancelled;
- Term 3 Finals will be replaced by Round 1 fixtures;
- The Round 1 fixtures (that were cancelled) will be played on Saturday 12 September;
- Certificates will be awarded to the team that finishes at the top of the ladder (similar to the situation in Term 1);
