Student Bus Travel Registration Procedure

- Review the information within this information pack including reading of the Student Bus Rules and 'Code of Conduct for Students Travelling on School Buses'.
- 2. Complete the online 'College Bus Registration Form.'
- 3. Paid bus passes need to be purchased in advance via Nexus <u>nexus.tsac.qld.edu.au/homepage/2088</u> or at College Reception, Secondary Campus.
- 4. The College Bus Co-ordinator will process your request and contact you to discuss details of your registration and provide you with the closest pickup/drop off options that are available to service your transport request.

Tickets for this service must be purchased in advance via Nexus <u>nexus.tsac.qld.edu.au/homepage/2088</u> or at the College Reception, Secondary Campus. The charges for term passes take into account the number of College days in each term.

Please note all students need to have a bus pass to get onto the College bus. **No pass. No trip**. Partially used bus tickets will not be refunded.

Students who are travelling between Campuses, and also those who travel to the train station need to register using the registration form (found on Nexus), and will be provided with an intercampus/train connection pass once their registration form is returned. The bus offered for Intercampus and train connections is a free service offered by the College.

The dedicated service provider for the TSAC College Bus Services is Belbaker Bus Charters. Belbaker Bus Charters are a professional company providing exceptional service and safety for their school and educational services. Features includes:

- GPS
- CCTV
- Driver monitoring software.

In partnership with Belbaker Bus Charters, the College operates four school bus routes for our enrolled students. We are governed in all our operations by the Queensland Government Transport Department and its "Public Transport" Legislations and Regulations. Please take the time to read carefully the 'Terms & Conditions', to which you must agree when you sign the Bus Application for student travel on The Springfield Anglican College buses.

Terms And Conditions For Safe Bus Travel

This bus regisration is only valid until the end of the school year, or upon your request to stop/terminate the bus arrangements. You are required to re-register at the end of a current year for student bus travel in the following year.

All bus runs are structured in such a way that your child may be picked up any time from 6:30am and dropped off before 5pm. After the bus arrangements have been made, the College reserves the right to make changes to any existing bus arrangements (times, location and bus run) after one Term notice.

All bus routes, directions, times and seating capacity are set at the beginning of each year. We are a growing school with increasing numbers of families requesting access to our bus service and as such, we are unable to offer a door to door service.

All the buses are mechanically maintained and serviced and operates in compliance with Queensland Passenger Transport Regulation and Conditions. The bus service is available for students from Prep to Year 12.

A limited free student bus transfer operates to and from Springfield Central Railway Station for students using the railway network. There is also a free intercampus bus transfer service that transfers students between Campuses. Please complete the Bus registration form so we can issue the student/s an intercampus

that they must show the driver each trip.

In the event that a student misses their stop, the driver will contact the Belbaker Bus Charters depot who will arrange for a parent/quardian to be contacted. Parents/quardians will be able to collect their student from ABCC; as the procedure is that the College bus will return any student who has missed their stop to ABCC at the conclusion of the bus run.

If you have a concern at any time during the published times of the bus run, please contact Belbaker Bus Charters depot directly on 1300 235 225.

All College bus services are subsidised by the College to assist in keeping these services affordable.

Student Bus Rules

Exemplary behaviour is expected from all students while they are travelling to and from College. Whenever students are wearing the College uniform, it is expected they will represent the College proudly.

Students travelling to or from College by bus/train are expected to uphold College standards of behaviour Incidences of poor behaviour on College or Public Transport will be taken very seriously by the College.

As a student using our buses you are required to:

- Be courteous and considerate to each other at all times.
- Obey the direction of the bus driver.
- Travel quietly and behave in accordance with The Springfield Anglican College standards.
- Not to use inappropriate language; it will not be tolerated.
- Not consume food or drinks.
- Be seated and remain seated with seat belt fastened.
- Not change seats during the journey.
- Respect all bus property, not interfere with bus seats or not put feet on the seats.
- Take care of their belongings on the bus. When leaving the bus, the students should check to ensure that they have all their belongings with them.
- Disembark the bus neatly in full College uniform.
- Not use head phones with any electronic devices.
- Not use aerosol sprays.

Rules for bus/train travel are designed to ensure a safe, comfortable and pleasant journey. Parents are encouraged to discuss the rules with their children, and impress upon them their importance.

Students who fail to observe bus rules will be subject to College discipline, and may forfeit their right to use bus services.
